This framework outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country. The methodology draws from the overall recommendations broad understanding arrived at by a Core Committee set up by MHRD, to identify the broad parameters for ranking various universities and institutions. The parameters broadly cover “Teaching, Learning and Resources,” “Research and Professional Practices,” “Graduation Outcomes,” “Outreach and Inclusivity,” and “Perception.”

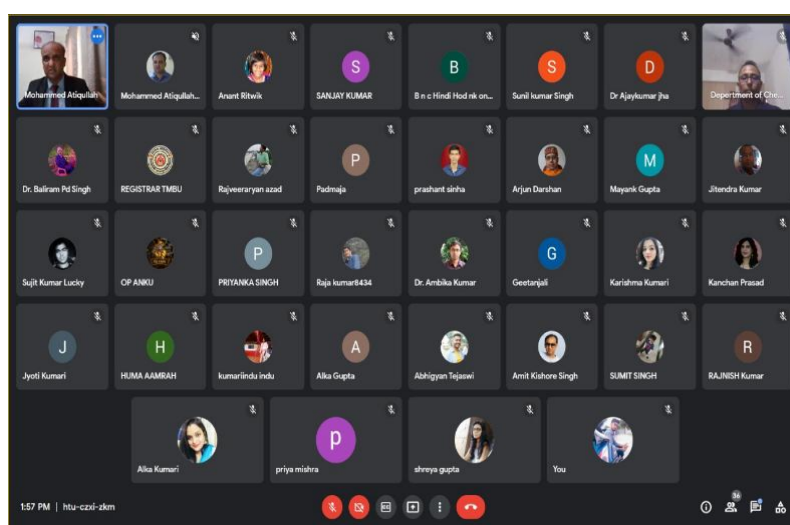
A one-day National Level Workshop on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) (12 march 2022)

Intellectual property (IP) pertains to any original creation of the human intellect such as artistic, literary, technical, or scientific creation. Intellectual property rights (IPR) refer to the legal rights given to the inventor or creator to protect his invention or creation for a certain period of time. These legal rights confer an exclusive right to the inventor/creator or his assignee to fully utilize his invention/creation for a given period of time. It is very well settled that IP play a vital role in the modern economy. It has also been conclusively established that the intellectual labour associated with the innovation should be given due importance so that public good emanates from it.

A National level workshop on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) was organized by recommendation of IQAC& Dept. of Chemistry in Collaboration with Govt. of India, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department for promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Office of the Controller General of Patents, Design and Trademarks on 15.03.2022. Almost 124 participants have registered in the event including all faculty members of the college.

Some of our faculty members are of strong research background. They are engaged in research activities in collaboration with different national/international research communities. Though our college does not have facility to perform sophisticated experiments, but the collaborated research works (with PG departments or with other colleges/universities) are always promoted. IQAC also felicitate faculty member(s), publishing a quality research paper. Apart from experimental articles by concerned department, they are also promoted to work in collaboration with other department of the college. Interdisciplinary research can reach a larger audience; it can inspire new trains of thought and questioning; it motivates students; and it builds critical thinking skills. Each faculty member was suggested to publish at least two research publications in a year. One of the faculty members (Dr. Amit Kishore Singh, HoD, Dept. of Botany) in our college could obtain a start-up research grant from UGC [File No. F.30-605/2021 (BSR); Amount: 10,00,000].

Participation of volunteers during the awareness drive organized by Dainik 'Prabhat Khabar': 16.04.2022

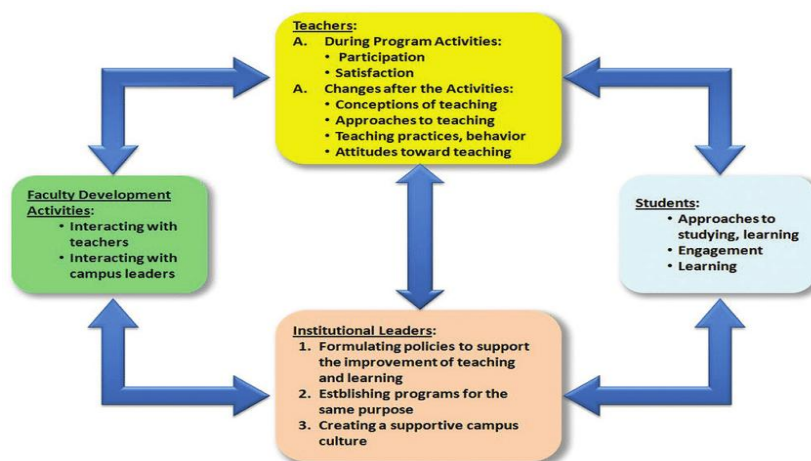
