
IQAC is pleased to share its Plan of Action towards quality enhancement and the Outcomes Achieved by the end of the Academic Year 2020-21.

1.	Preparation of Academic Calander	Academic calendar for the session 2020-21 was prepared by the concerned committee.	
2.	More participation of students in extra curriculum activities for their overall personality development	The concerned sections of the college, e.g., NSS, NCC, Cultural Committee, Sport Committee were suggested to promote students for their participation in these activities. Accordingly, various activities were conducted inside and outside the campus.	
3.	Promotion of Community interaction among students and local residents.	An initiative was taken in collaboration with NSS to obtain an experience of community interaction among faculty members, students and local residents.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the teaching learning process had to be converted to online mode. To facilitate the same, IQAC of B. N. College, Bhagalpur had promoted to create google class rooms to conduct classes online through google meetings. IQAC organized several meetings at a short notice to help teachers in equipping them for the same.
